Eligibility and Selection Criteria:

- The scholarship program is available to undergraduate, graduate, and law school students as well as incoming college freshmen at an accredited U.S. School.
- The candidate must be in good academic standing with at least a 3.0 minimum cumulative GPA.

Application Requirements:

The Tony Munter Whistleblower Attorney Scholarship program invites all candidates who meet the aforementioned criteria to apply. Applicants will be evaluated based on the following:

- A completed application (see details below).
- A 750 essay on the value of transparency and accountability in the applicant's current, desired, or future career. The essay should reflect a thoughtful approach to the issue.
- An academic transcript from the applicant's most recent educational institution (including the applicant's most recent year in school).
